The Carroll County Board of DD met for their regular monthly meeting Thursday, June 24, 2010 and adopted a new Vision Statement which reads: “It is the vision of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities to provide an integrated service system that promotes growth and personal satisfaction for both individuals and families.” The Mission Statement will remain the same. It states: “It is the mission of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities program to provide quality services to those living with developmental disabilities, supporting them, and their families to unlock their potential.” They also adopted a set of Core Values with the acronym of CARROLL HILLS – Commitment, Accountability, Respect, Responsibility, Overcoming adversity, Leadership, Literacy Habilitation, Integrity, Learning, Living Safely.

In other business, the Board:

- adopted a new Waiting List Policy;
- approved a new position description for Early Intervention Specialist/Service Coordinator;
- adopted a new pay rate for Substitute Service and Support Administrator of \$11.23 per hour;
- voted not to hold a regular meeting in July nor in December as it is only necessary to conduct 10 regular meetings per year.
