Superintendent Matt Campbell began the meeting of the Carroll County Board of DD by thanking the members for sending him to the 2010 Ohio Association of County Boards of Developmental Disabilities Spring Conference held May 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. He reported Governor Strickland was present on the first day and congratulated the Developmental Disabilities Boards for doing such a good job of providing quality services while operating with a reduced budget. John Martin, Director of the OACBDD, shared National Core Indicators information showing Ohio is performing near, at, and above quality indicators. Mr. Campbell stated, "Our system is working and will exist because we embrace changes as better ways of doing business and improving services for people with developmental disabilities."

In other business, the Board:

- heard Mr. Heaston report he, Mr. Campbell, and Mrs. Hall, Director of Educational Services met with representatives from Brown Local, Minerva, and Carrollton School Districts where it was agreed upon that the school districts will assume the costs of therapy services for the students within their districts;
- approved the 2010-2011 Program Calendar;
- approved revisions to the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual;
- learned a Self-Advocacy Council has been formed comprised of individuals with developmental disabilities allowing them more control over their environment.
