At the regular April meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held April 28, 2016 the Board heard from Superintendent Matt Campbell that Carroll Hills School received a \$5,000 donation from Carroll County Energy Facility Project on March 7, 2016. The money will be used to purchase interactive white boards for 2 to 3 classes. The Board received official confirmation of acceptance of plan of correction and award of a 3 year accreditation from the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) on March 28, 2016. The 3 year accreditation is good from April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2019. The letter from DODD Director John Martin stated "you, the Board members, your Superintendent and staff are to be commended for your efforts in achieving this status. Department staff and I are well aware that this accomplishment required considerable commitment of resources and energy. Our accreditation process was designed to assist county boards in continuously improving the quality of their services and supports to individuals with disabilities. Your efforts are now acknowledged as being in substantial compliance with state accreditation standards."

Superintendent Campbell met with Mid East Ohio Regional Council staff on March 17 and April 4, 2016 to develop the provider recruitment plan for Carroll County. Carroll County is part of 5 other county boards in Region #5 that have created ImagiNetwork to recruit private providers as required by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid rules. The ImagiNetwork meeting will occur on May 4, 2016 from 3:00 to 6:00 PM held at the Muskingum County Welcome Center 205 North 5th Street Zanesville, Ohio 43701. RSVP <http://www.planetreg.com/imagiNetwork-kick-off>. Providers are asked to come hear what the service needs are for each county board.

Superintendent Campbell gave an update on the privatization of Carroll Hills Industries. Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities will invite the public to community forums on privatization in June 2016. Board staff are in the process of getting approval to expand septic system capacity and building occupancy at the Carroll Hills Administration building as preparation for Carroll Hills Industries to move services to this location.

Business Manager Ray Heaston reported the 3 buses were delivered from Myers Equipment and the Board received \$71,250 from the EPA Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Program. The contract between Tuscarawas County Board of Developmental Disabilities is going very well. The Board is moving electronic records from a server that is contracted through GBS to a cloud server. The Board is also in the middle of a 2012 and 2013 cost report audit.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$969.98 for March bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$59,572.58 for March bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$5,055.52 for March bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Program Division Reports;
- approved the 2016 – 2017 Carroll Hills Program Calendar;
- approved the Carroll County Board of DD and Carroll Hills Industries Inc. April 28, 2016 to January 1, 2018 adult services contract;
- approved 1 new applications for Family Selected Services;
- entered into executive session at 6:01 pm to consider compensation of a public employee. Executive session ended at 6:43 pm.
- Approved a 5 year superintendent contract from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2020 with salary remaining the same, addendum for SSA Director duties increasing from \$25,000 to \$30,000, and 6 weeks of vacation;
