At the regular April meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held April 27, 2017 Mr. Campbell updated the Board on the progress of privatization, bus inspection, and service coordination. The renovation at 1182 Roswell Road is near completion. The last renovation project of the front offices at 540 North High Street started today. Carroll Hills Industries is awaiting provider certification approval. All 5 buses passed inspection. The Help Me Grow name will remain with Ohio Department of Health for home visiting. Early Intervention is now called Ohio Early Intervention and is overseen by Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities. Central Coordination is still overseen by the Ohio Department of Health. Service Coordination is now overseen by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities and called Bold Beginning.

Mr. Campbell would like to find an agency to create videos of success stories in Early Intervention, school age, community employment etc. This will be away to showcase Board services and promote local business that partner with the Board. These videos would be available on the Board website and possibly as television ads.

Business Manager Ray Heaston reported sending a contract to Harrison Hills School District for one existing Carroll Hills School student who recently moved to Harrison County. He informed the Board of the need to replace a copier that is 6 years old at the school and one that is 8 years old for the administration. Mr. Heaston is also coordinating the Information Technology system transfer between the 1182 Roswell building and 540 North High Street location as part of the privatization process.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$1,862.59 for March bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$121,374.56 for March bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$9,859.85 for March bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the 2017-2018 Carroll Hills Program calendar;
- approved the encumbering \$25,000 matching funds for a grant from Strong Families Safe Communities helping Ohio children and youth in crisis. This grant pays the salary of a Dual Diagnosis Community Interventionist that is shared between Carroll County Board of DD, Tuscarawas County Board of DD, and Tuscarawas Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board;
