At the regular February meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held February 23rd, the Board heard Superintendent Matt Campbell report the Department of Developmental Disabilities reviewed the Board on November 16 and 17, 2011 as part of the accreditation process. The Board was awarded a 4 year Accreditation thanks to the hard work of staff. A special thank you is in order for Kelly Wells from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council and SSA Director Jan Clayborn for Accreditation preparedness. The 2011 Annual Report is available on our website or can be picked up at our administration office. The Board employed 89 staff compared to 2010 employing 99 staff. Out service numbers for children and adults reduced from 232 in 2010 to 195 in 2011. Revenue decreased by \$1,150,169. The Board was able to reduce expenses by \$262,213. However, the Board still had a reduction of reserve money by \$368,117 for 2011.

In other business, the Board:

- Patti Gotschall was sworn in as a new Board member;
- approved payment of \$1,086.56 in the Hot Lunch fund;
- approved payment of \$101,226.91 in the Carroll County Board of DD General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$7,120 in the Special Levy fund account;
- Approved the Ethics Council Recommendations of 2 applications for Family Selected Services;
- Held an executive session to discuss matters involving employee compensation;
