At the regular June meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held June 26th, the Board heard from Superintendent Matt Campbell that he received an email from Ohio Department of Education that the Board meets requirements for the 2012-2013 school year. He attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting at Franklin County Board of DD on June 13, 2014. Bridget Gargan reported that Ohio Association of County Boards of Developmental Disabilities will hold a Board officer meeting in late July so all 88 County Boards will be updated on the new Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) rule and how it will affect the future of Board services in Ohio. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities created a state system issues, person centered planning, residential settings, adult day waivers services setting, and conflict of interest committees to address the transition plan to meet the new Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services rule. Christine Brown from Brown-Coley Associates in Self-Determination visited Carroll Hills Industries on June 17, 2014. Self-advocacy continues to grow with Kristen Long and Gregory DeLong finished training their first class of self-advocates at Carroll Hills Industries. The Board is sending 8 more adults for Project STIR (Steps Toward Independence and Responsibility) training at Columbus Worthington from August 18 through 21, 2014. It is time again to schedule for the required 4 hours of Board training. Board members can receive the 4 hours of training by attending transportation trainings on August 14 or 19 and 15 or 18; attend staff in-service on October 17; or attend trainings after Board meetings.
