At the regular June meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held June 25, 2015 the Board heard from Superintendent Matt Campbell that he attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on June 12, 2015 held at Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities. County Boards will be required to switch to a new eligibility tool called Level of Care starting July 1, 2015. The new Free Choice of Provider rule requires Boards to recruit private providers, reduce number of individuals receiving Waiver dollars from using Board services, and allows the Board to have Service and Support Administrators (SSA) staff help individuals pick a private provider. A rating system for providers is being looked at which includes Angie's list and Arizona's provider list.

Mr. Campbell attended a webinar on June 23, 2015 and listened to Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) Director Martin discuss Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) response to conflict free case management. Carroll County Board of DD has until 2024 to address transportation and day services. The Board has until September 1, 2015 to send DODD benchmarks and implementation plan to recruit private providers and reduce number of individuals on Waivers who receive services from the Board.

Business Manager Ray Heaston reported progress on the Information Technology (IT) upgrade project. All three buildings are now connected on a wide area network (WAN) and now have the Metro E high speed internet service. The contracted IT Network Administrator has been installing equipment and setting up the network infrastructure.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$1,262.15 for May bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$124,566.71 for May bills in the General Fund account;
- approved payment of \$5,099.60 for May bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved payment of \$15,835.43 for May bills in the DD School Levy account;
- approved the Program Division Reports;
- approved revisions to the Training Coordinator and Early Childhood Intervention Specialist job descriptions;
- approved new job descriptions for Integration Coordinator and Job Coach;
- approved a resolution recognizing the Americans with Disabilities 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary;

- approved encumbering \$213,750 matching funds for an Environmental Agency Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Program for fiscal year 2015 to purchase 3 new buses if awarded the \$71,250 grant;
