At the regular June meeting held on June 28, 2018 Mr. Campbell attend the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting held at Delaware County Board of DD on June 8, 2018. Jessica Stewart and John Wysocki from Special Olympics Ohio discussed the need for a coordinator and assistant coordinator in each county and program expectations. Deputy Director Lori Horvath from The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities discussed changes in the waiting list. A memo was sent out discussing inducements and time limited vocational rehabilitation for Waiver providers.

Mr. Campbell attended the SSA Forum on June 27, 2018 held at Xenos Center in Columbus. The new waiting list rule for Medicaid Waiver funding will go into effect September 1, 2018. The current list will be froze and everyone on it will be contacted to complete an assessment of need. Any immediate need the Board must handle with either local resources or waiver funding. Anyone assessed with a current need that needs addressed within the next year will be placed on the waiting list. People will be removed from the waiting list if they do not have a current need. This will streamline the process and make sure people get their needs met faster.

Carroll County Sheriff's Department will be hiring the resource officer for Carroll Hills School. This will ensure all training requirements are met and provide a replacement officer if the resource officer was off work.

## In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of \$2,033 for May bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$81,817.59 for May bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$9,091.94 for May bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Ethics Council recommendations of 5 new and 20 renewal applications for Family Selected Services;
- approved the entering into a contract with MEORC for employment services for 50 individuals at the rate of \$12,000 per year;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- entered executive session at 6:14 pm to consider the compensation of a public employee. Executive session ended at 6:29 pm.
