At the regular May meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held June 6th, the Board heard from Sean Shawler a Carroll Hills Industries Employee and Rhonda Powals his mother and bus driver for Carroll Hills. Sean gave the Board a thank you card for paying for him and Greg DeLong to attend Project STIR which was a train the trainer program (Steps Toward Independence and Responsibility). He reported learning a lot about budgeting and problem solving. Sean said he had fun.

Superintendent Matt Campbell attended the Ohio Association of County Boards Spring Conference on May 23 and 24. Topics of interest included P.L.A.Y. (Play and Language for Autistic Youngsters), HIPAA changes (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act), employment first, collaboration, ACA (Affordable Care Act), and House Bill 59. Mr. Campbell attended the Project MORE (Mentoring in Ohio for Reading Excellence) conference held at Bowling Green University. Alicia Hall, Chrystal Day, and Mr. Campbell were presenters talking about our full implementation of Project MORE. This is the second year of Project MORE and we had 13 mentors and 9 mentees. Mentors consisted of Carrollton High School students and Carroll Hills staff.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved the implementation of the employee incentive plan. Employees must now earn base pay increases through evaluation scores. Staff can earn depending on the job description and evaluation score \$0 to \$1,650 per year. This new incentive plan is part of the work with Dublin Management to create a better employee evaluation, eliminate steps that were just based on years worked, implement salary ranges based on market data, and link pay increases to work performance.
- approved payment of \$677.79 for April bills in the Hot Lunch fund;
- approved payment of \$59,199.15 for April bills in the Carroll County Board of DD General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$28,347.68 for April bills in the Residential Services fund;
- approved the Ethics Council Recommendations of 1 applications for Family Selected Services;
