At the regular May meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held May 28, 2015 the Board heard from Superintendent Matt Campbell that he attended the Ohio Mid-East Government Agency transportation meeting held on May 6 at Carrollton Library. Mr. Campbell expressed the need for public transportation after the hours of 4 pm Monday through Friday and also on weekends. Mr. Campbell also attended the Ohio Association of County Boards 2015 Spring Conference held on May 14 and 15 at Columbus Hilton Easton. Topics of discussion were technology and person centered planning, emerging from the great recession, The PLAY project, Medicaid Home and Community Based Services, future of DD services, and free choice of provider rule. Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities is expected to employ 4 new people in community employment each year until 2024 to help the state meet a 50% average of individuals with developmental disabilities working in the community.

The Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities has been successful with recruiting private providers to perform all non-medical transportation. St. John's Villa, Family Disability Services, and Mayle Homes provides transportation for all individuals receiving federal waiver dollars. Mayle Homes started providing day services in October 2014. Carroll County residents receiving federal waiver dollars may choose day services from Carroll Hills Industries, St. John's Villa, The Farm, and Mayle Homes. Data from Fiscal Year 2014 shows Carroll County had 34.06% adults in county run day services (Carroll Hills Industries) and 65.94% in private run adult day services (St. John's Villa, The Farm, and Mayle Homes).

Mr. Campbell reported the Board has to perform radon testing every 3 years. Sylcom Safety Specialists completed the radon testing at all 3 locations and our facility was found not to have any rooms above the radon action level of 4.0pCi/L.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$1,228.60 for April bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$56,728.28 for April bills in the General Fund account;
- approved payment of \$44,511.25 for April bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Program Division Reports;
- approved 1 new application for Family Selected Services;

- approved the Carroll Hills Program calendar for 2015-2016;
- approved encumbering \$25,000 matching funds for a grant from Strong Families Safe Communities helping Ohio children and youth in crisis. This grant pays the salary of a Dual Diagnosis Community Interventionist that is shared between Carroll County Board of DD, Tuscarawas County Board of DD, and Tuscarawas Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board;
- entered executive session at 6:07 PM to consider the compensation of a public employee and returned to regular session at 6:27 PM;
- Approved a new salary range for Director of Educational Services in the amount of \$54,000 to \$74,000;
