At the regular November meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held November 17th, the Board heard Superintendent Matt Campbell talk about Ohio minimum wage will increase to \$7.70 starting January 1, 2012. Carroll Hills subs currently make \$7.75 per hour. It has been over 3 years since employees received an increase to their pay scales. The Board should consider a 3% increase and hiring Dublin Management to conduct an evaluation of current employee pay and make recommendations on how to move from a step system for classified staff to a pay for performance system. Starting January 1, 2012 Carroll County Transit will take over the last adult route from the Board. The current Board driver will retire in December. The Board will only be providing transportation for students and contracting for all adult services transportation.

In other business, the Board:

- The Board welcomed Laryssa Beatty as a new member who was appointed by Probate Judge John Campbell;
- Jennifer Thomas was reappointed by the Commissioners to serve a second term on the Board;
- approved payment of \$1,555.70 in the Hot Lunch fund;
- approved payment of \$83,838.20 in the Carroll County Board of DD General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$17,571.45 in the Family Support Services fund used for match of Medicaid services;
- The Board is searching for a new board member appointed by the Commissioners. Board member applications are available on our website;
- The Board approved the 2012 operating budget for Hot Lunch fund \$15,000, Permanent Improvement fund \$20,000, Special Levy fund \$528,500, and Board Operating fund of \$3,695,400;
- The Board approved the 2012 resolution to pay the non-federal share of Medicaid expenditures in the amount of up to \$215,000.
