At the regular October meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held October 27, 2016 the Board heard that Superintendent Mr. Campbell attended the Ohio Superintendent of County Board Executive Committee Meeting held at Delaware County Board of DD on October 14, 2016 at 10:00 am. The work session consisted of review and discuss emerging trends and recent developments that have financial/structural implications for county boards. The task was to discuss the design of funding infrastructure in the future, the county board vision for 2024. The design package concepts included move to a one waiver system which bases services and cost limits on assessed needs, redesign the waiting list to reflect current unmet needs, use state generated funds currently paid directly to counties to increase the portion of match paid by the state, cap a county board's cost per individual with the state covering costs that exceed the cap, base a county board's match contribution on an objective measure of county wealth/poverty, and assure full state funding for waiver related state initiatives for at least a multi-year pilot period.

It is time to work on the 2017 Annual Action Plan. The Annual Action Plan is the implementation of the Board's 2014 – 2018 Strategic Plan. The Board's 3 goals are to improve the quality, efficiency, and effectiveness of Board services; increase community education and awareness of the need for Board services; and to strive to be more person centered. Annual Action Plan surveys are available on the Carroll Hills website (carrollhills.com) and at the administration office. The public hearing is scheduled for December 5 from 2 – 4 PM at the administration building (1182 Roswell Road NW).

Mr. Campbell and Ray Heaston attended a Commissioner meeting on 10-13-2016 to request transfer of the 540 North High Street property (the Workshop) from the Commissioners to the County Board. The property was purchased in 1978 utilizing 87.5% State Department of Developmental Disability funds and County Board local levy match. The building was renovated 3 times utilizing funding from the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities and County Board local levy money. The 540 North High Street location will be renovated for administration offices, service and support administrators (SSA case management), community employment services, and day services for individuals without Medicaid Waivers.

Business Manager Ray Heaston reported entering into a contract with Countryview Manor in order for an individual who recently moved there to continue adult day services at Carroll Hills Industries. The Board also renewed a contract with Tuscarawas County Board of Developmental Disabilities for informational technology services. Mr. Heaston also reported that Carroll County is staying with CEBCO health insurance and the premium cost will increase by 5.9%.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$1,404.73 for September bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$56,580.76 for September bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$11,263.28 for September bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities and Carroll Hills Industries adult services contract for August 22, 2016 through December 31, 2017;
- approved the revision to the vacation buy out policy from two weeks to 6 weeks;
- entered executive session at 6:24 pm to consider the matter required to be kept confidential by federal law or regulations or state statutes. Executive session ended at 6:45 pm;
- approved 1 new and 1 renewal applications for Family Selected Services;
