At the regular September meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held September 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Board heard Superintendent Matt Campbell talk about the management team's review of the 2009 to 2013 Strategic Plan. Goal #1 is to improve the quality, efficiency, and effectiveness of Board services. Items addressing #1 were restructuring and reduction of staff positions through Early Retirement Incentive Plan and attrition. Goal #2 increase community education and awareness of the need for Board services. Staff has been volunteering at the Fair, Back to School Extravaganza, Information Fair, and other events. The Board has Under the Umbrella newsletter and also places articles in the local newspapers. Goal #3 strives to be more consumer driven has been addressed by community surveys and development of a self-advocate group called CHIT CHAT.

In other business, the Board:

- The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities Accreditation Team will evaluate the program on November 16 and 17, 2011.
- Approved the addition of executive secretary, 9 month bus driver, and music trainer along with the elimination of job coach, mechanic, and confidential secretary 1 and 2 from the pay scale.
- Made a resolution to send Department of Developmental Disabilities consolidated subsidies to the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities general fund.
- Approved the 2011 to 2012 Carroll Hills School bus and van routes.
- Approved the recommendation of the Ethics Council for 4 Family Support Services renewals.
- Held an executive session to discuss matters involving Employee Compensation.
