At the regular September meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held September 24, 2015 the Board heard from Superintendent Matt Campbell that he attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on September 11, 2015 held at Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities. Topics covered were the new guardianship rules, free choice of provider, privatization and ownership of county buildings, issues with Self-Waiver rules, Individual Options Waiver waiting list rules with new family living designated waivers, and benchmark reports due to Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities by October 1, 2015.

Mr. Campbell and Mr. Heaston attended the Budget Symposium on September 1, 2015 held at the Xenos Community Center in Columbus. The partnership between county boards and Opportunities for Ohioans with Developmental Disabilities has resulted in 426 job placements across the state. Ohio Department of Education will have a similar project where 26 counselors across the state will be available for school districts to transition students with disabilities to jobs. County Boards are required to provide counseling for anyone interested in entering an Intermediate Care Facility. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities plans to move 2,890 individuals receiving Transitional Developmental Disability Waivers to Individual Options Waivers by July 1, 2017.

Mr. Campbell reported receiving an email from the Ohio Department of Education that Carroll Hills School 2015 Special Education rating is "Meets Requirements". The primary basis of this rating is the final special education program data the district submitted through EMIS for the 2013-2014 school year.

Mr. Campbell received a notice of award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in the amount of \$71,250 to purchase 3 new buses. The Board will have a year to purchase the new school buses from October 1, 2015.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$4,273.03 for August bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$100,406.20 for August bills in the General Fund account;
- approved payment of \$3,629.85 for August bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Program Division Reports;

- approved paying the entire 11.1% insurance increase for 2016 in the amount of approximately \$68,000 which includes the increase for Board share and full-time employee share;
- approved 2 new application for Family Selected Services;
