At the regular September meeting of the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities held September 23, 2016 the Board heard that Superintendent Mr. Campbell attended the Ohio Superintendent of County Board Executive Committee Meeting held at Franklin County Board of DD on September 9, 2016 at 10:00 am. Ball v. Kasich lawsuit was discussed with the current request for class action lawsuit. November 1, 2016 will start the Adult services redesign in which all day service providers must provide at least on skill development for each person with disabilities served. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities will be increasing visits to providers that are in violation of 2014 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services rule. Providers have to be compliant with community integration, day services separation from residential services, and person centered services.

Mr. Campbell reported phase 1 of the privatization process for Carroll Hills Industries has started. Four individuals who receive adult services have already been moved to the 1182 Roswell Road location due to a team leader being hired as a job coach. We will be moving staff and individuals receiving services before January 1, 2018 to avoid moving people twice and so renovation can occur in both buildings.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$1,845.54 for August bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$73,134.73 for August bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$11,349.87 for August bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved revisions to the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual;
- approved the estimate of \$18,225 minus the pavilion roof for Wade Hutt Construction to replace the roof at the administration building;
- approved the 2016-2017 bus and van routes;
- entered executive session at 6:13 pm to consider the compensation of a public employee. Executive session ended at 6:30 pm;
- approved 3 new and 1 renewal applications for Family Selected Services;
