At the regular September meeting held on September 28, 2017 Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on September 8 at Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities. Kim Hauck for the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities discusses issues with Cleveland Sight Center lack of referrals to County Board service coordinators. Scott Marks from Ohio Association of County Boards reported the committee recommendation for Non-Medical Transportation rate be added to existing services such as community employment, vocational, and day habilitation. Director Martin talked about the status of the Disability Rights Ohio lawsuit. Ohio Provider Resource Association (OPRA) is pushing for a statewide application and implementation of Direct Support Professional to address direct care staff shortage.

Mr. Campbell reported receiving an email from the Ohio Department of Education that Carroll Hills School 2017 Special Education rating is "Meets Requirements". The primary basis of this rating is the final special education program data the district submitted through EMIS for the 2015-2016 school year.

Mr. Campbell gave an update on privatization of Carroll Hills Industries. Carroll Hills Industries was approved by The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities as a Home and Community Based Service and Supported Living provider. CHI will begin billing for day services on October 1, 2017. The Board held an open house and provider fair on September 12, 2017. Carroll Hills Industries will be privatized January 1, 2018. The Board continues to provide day habilitation services for 12 people without Medicaid Waiver funding and 10 people from AR 2 Rescare Intermediate Care Facility.

Mr. Heaston reported receiving notice of a desk review Audit for 2014 regarding Medicaid Administrative Claiming. Medicaid Administrative Claiming generates around \$100,000 per year.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$7,610 for August bills in the DD School Levy account;
- approved payment of \$129,016.13 for August bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$5,199.89 for August bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the Carroll County Board Subsidy policy;
- approved the revised Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual;
