At the regular September meeting held on September 27, 2018 Mr. Campbell attend the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting held at Delaware County Board of DD on September 14, 2018. The Ohio Association Services for Children will meet at the end of October to develop a strategic plan. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities is in the process of completing HIPAA compliance reviews of all county boards due to being business associates. The Non-Medical Transportation revised rates were discussed. Rebecca C. Princehorn, Esq. presented on planning levy campaigns. A rally at the Ohio Statehouse will be held on September 27, 2018 from 11:00 am – 1:00 pm in support of Bridge2Equality. Bridge2 Equality is a rally to raise awareness of the critical staffing crisis effecting the services and lives of people with developmental disabilities.

The public hearing for the Strategic Plan has been moved to October 2, 2018 from 6 to 7 pm at the Board offices. CEBCO informed the Commissioners that the wellness program will continue to be offered to only employees but CEBCO will no longer offer the \$200 per employee incentive. The Commissioners are asking if each department would like to pay the incentive and want to keep the incentive uniform.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of \$953.46 for August bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$101,445.73 for August bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$19,956.81 for August bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- approved up to \$200 per employee incentive for employees that successfully complete the wellness program;
- approved to make the employee share of the insurance premium 8.5%. The employee share of the premium has remained the same over the last 8 years;
- approved the Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities 2018 to 2019 School year bus routes;
- approved to raise the sub classroom aide rates from \$8.45 to \$9.57 per hour;
- entered executive session at 5:56 pm to consider matter required to be kept confidential by federal law or regulations or state statutes. Executive session ended at 6:33 pm.
