5) Are you happy with the service provider options in Carroll County? Should the Board recruit more providers for day services, transportation, workshop services, and community employment?

6) What is your thoughts on integrating services? This means we will have to reduce the number of people receiving housing, day, and workshop services in one setting. Anyone who receives services will have to get more services in the community. We are very open to input on how to improve our services by integration.

8) Please give us feedback on the privatization of Carroll Hills Industries. How can we help you with transition of services to private providers? What services should the Board provide for those who are not receiving Federal money (Medicaid Waivers) and will remain at 540 North High Street?
