INTENT TO PARTICIPATE:

1. It is the intent of the Board to provide services to persons eligible for County Board of hv1RIDD services under the Title XX program and to submit service profiles as part of the Carroll County Comprehensive Service Plan. The service profiles shall be in accordance with the current Program Goals, Objectives and Services as promulgated by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.
2. The Board shall submit its plan to public comment through the hearing process held through the Carroll County Board of Commissioners for the Can-oll County Comprehensive Service Plan.
3. The Board shall submit required documentation of services provided and application for reimbursement through the approved forms as promulgated by the Ohio Department of MR/DD and the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services in such marine- and frequency as prescribed by the foregoing agencies.

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

The Board will comply with the following requirements for each service component for which it intends to bill:

1. Ensure that the services shall be recommended and provided by qualified personnel as determined by reference to the Ohio civil service system, occupational standards, state and local licensing and certification and applicable laws.
2. Demonstrate the ability to provide services in accordance with applicable sections of the Ohio Administrative Code; and
3. Operate in accordance with any applicable laws, chartering, accreditation or certification standards or an approved plan of correction.

INCOME ELIGIBILITY:

1. Title XX Service shall be provided without regard to income as of 7-1-01.

REDETERMINATION:

1. Title XX service recipients shall be reviewed on at least an annual basis for evidence of continued eligibility and the need for continuing Title XX services shall be

reviewed at the annual service plan meeting for the individual. Should a COEDJIOEDI as applicable re-administered during the service year determine that an individual is ineligible for County Board of MRIDD Services, no further Title XX billings shall be made for such individual. This policy shall not be construed as to require in itself the re-administration of the COEDHIOEDI instruments for Title XX purposes but only to address how Title XX participation shall be affected by such administration if and when it should occur.

PROCEDURES

The superintendent is authorized to promulgate such procedures as may be deemed necessary to effectively implement this policy.

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
